In addition, I am requesting any documentation listing the amount of dues deducted from the member employees’ paychecks each pay period for remittance to District 155 Education Association, as well as any documentation listing the amount of fees deducted from nonmember employees’ paychecks each pay period for remittance to District 155 Education Association.”
